- Executing product flow transports from western refineries to OMV affiliates in different countries and be the single point of contact for refining logistics / dispatching.
- Being responsible for operational execution, contract management and close cooperation with railways, forwarders and shipping companies.
- Leading, managing and developing primary logistics operations team, serve as a substitute for primary logistics department manager.
- Being responsible for coordinating implementation of STO decisions and serve as substitute of logistics representative in STO team, empowered to decide on behalf of Logistics West as well as representing OMV regarding operational topics in front of transport service providers and external transport associations (e.g. Via Donau).
- Leading projects and initiatives related to improvement of operational and optimization processes within primary logistics.
